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INTRODUCTION



Blinkfire's annual end-of-year report is your guide to understanding the sports and entertainment industry. We recapped the year to show you how sponsorships are integrated into content to create valuable brand exposure and the trends that are driving the market.

We dive into sponsorship asset benchmarking across the top sports leagues in the world, why short-form video content is surging, the year's top broadcast moments, the most viral trends, and much more.

We hope this report gives brands, teams, organizations, agencies, and influencers a look into the data they need to turn their content into measurable success.

This report is powered by Blinkfire's proprietary social media, digital, broadcast, and sponsorship analytics platform, which tracks and measures performance across sports, entertainment and culture at a global scale.

Data Sources

Insights in this report are based on data collected from official owned and earned social media accounts for teams, leagues, organizations, brands, athletes, influencers, celebrities, musicians, media companies, and events tracked by Blinkfire.

Platform Coverage

Data includes activity across major social platforms, including Instagram, Facebook, TikTok, YouTube, X, Threads, and Sina Weibo (where applicable).

Time Period

Unless otherwise noted, analysis reflects activity from January 1, 2025 to November 15, 2025. Certain league highlights, events, and seasonal analyses use custom dates aligned to the respective league's calendar year.

Metrics & Valuation

Blinkfire measures performance and valuation using metrics such as followers, engagement, views, and impressions (estimated).

CONTENT FORMATS DRIVING ENGAGEMENT

Social media in 2025 showed a significant shift toward dynamic formats compared to the previous year, with total posts increasing in Blinkfire by 24.9%. The most substantial growth was seen in mixed media and video posts. This indicates a growing preference for more short-form, engaging video content across major social platforms. In contrast to the growth in video and mixed media, total image posts experienced a decline of 4.6%, suggesting that images are being deprioritized across sports and entertainment.

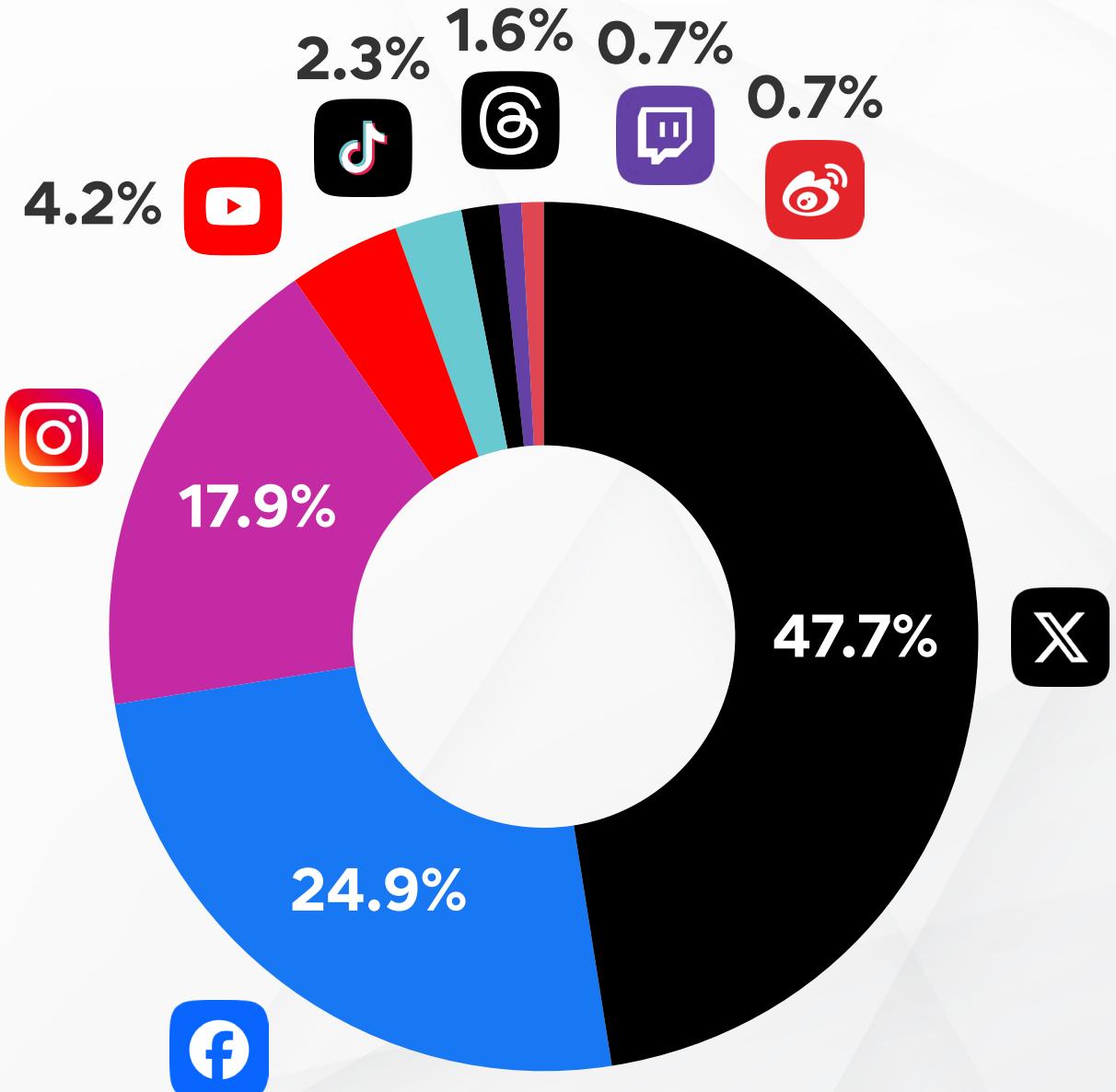

PLATFORM GROWTH TRENDS



Despite X making up nearly 50% of social media posts, posts in Blinkfire saw a 5% decline. TikTok posts increased 28%, Threads 78%, and YouTube 14%.

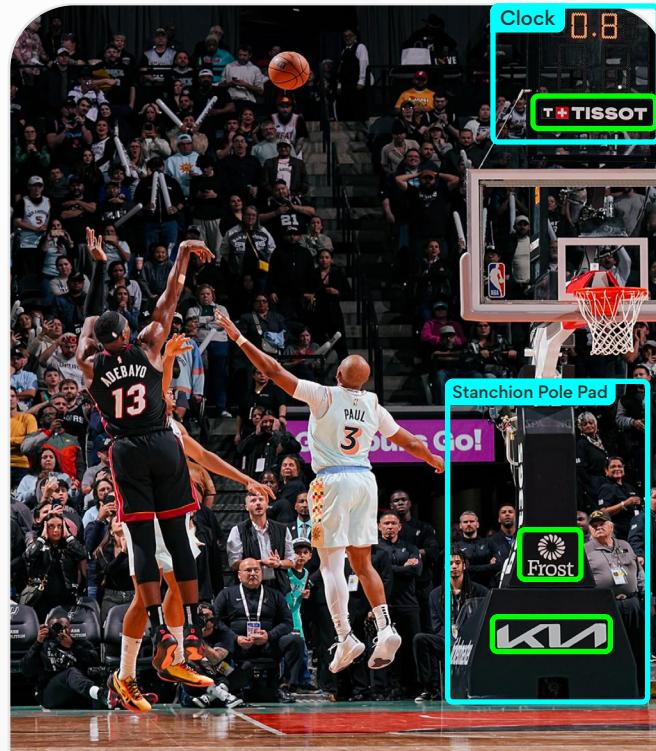

THE STATE OF SOCIAL MEDIA: SPORTS & ENTERTAINMENT



To get a snapshot of where the sports and entertainment ecosystem is headed, we conducted a deep analysis across major leagues and teams. While valuation on Instagram—which drives 80% of total value—declined by 4.9%, it was offset by aggressive growth on other platforms. Surging valuations on TikTok (+77.7%), Facebook (+25.8%), and YouTube (+17.7%) helped keep the year-over-year values flat. Meanwhile, overall views grew 23%, driven by TikTok (+86%) and Facebook (+63%). We also saw an interesting split on X: Team growth was stagnant, but leagues drove a 28% increase in views.

THE FINANCIAL HEAVYWEIGHTS

While American sports often dominate headline revenue, the social media valuation landscape paints a different picture, heavily favoring global European soccer and cricket.

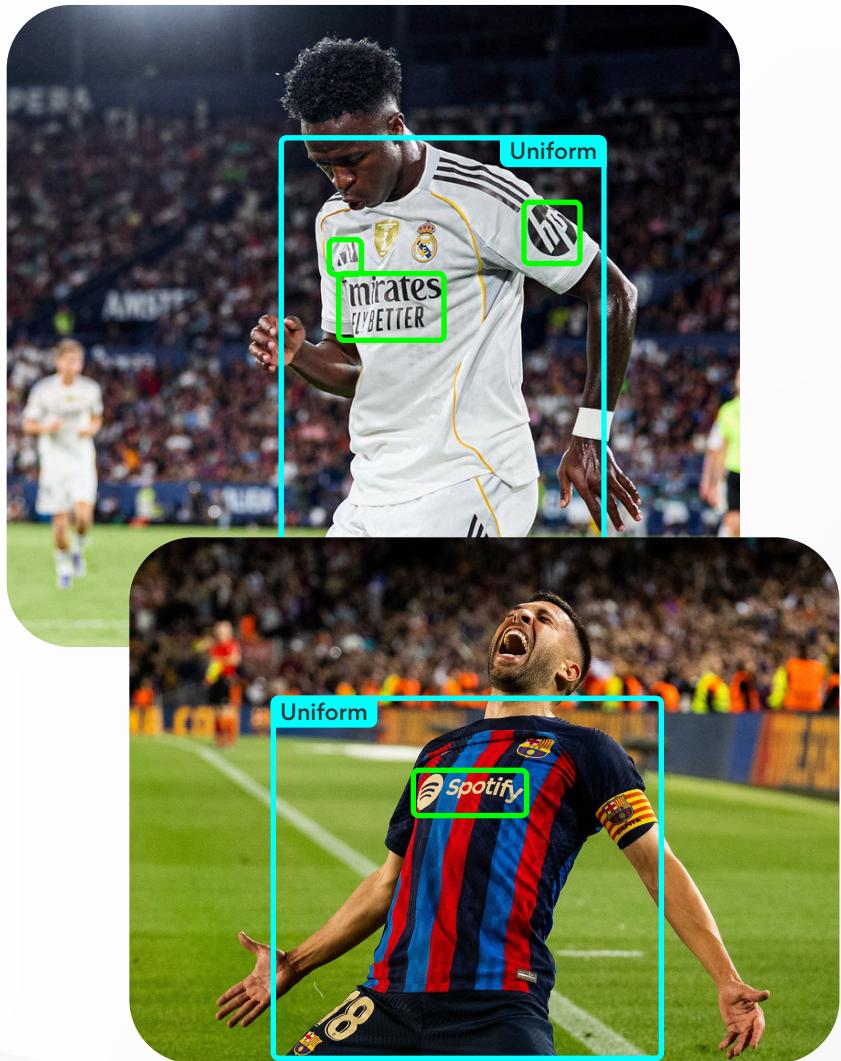
LALIGA (\$4.4 billion) and the **Premier League** (\$2.9 billion), are driven by the massive global reach of super-clubs like Real Madrid, FC Barcelona, Liverpool FC, and Manchester United. Indian Premier League teams drove a staggering \$3.89 billion in media value. **Formula 1** (\$1.17 billion) and the **NBA** (\$900 million) round out the top five.

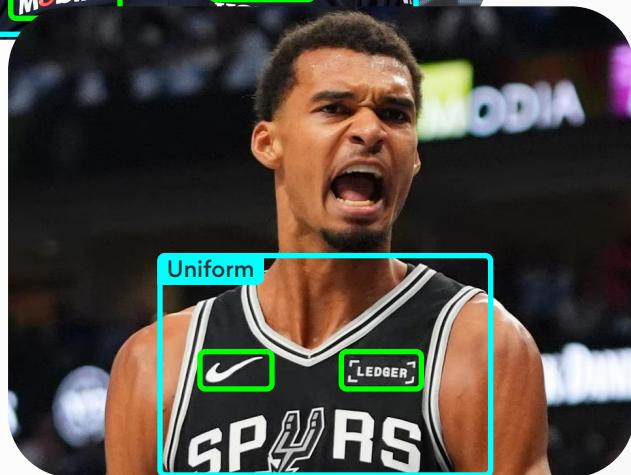

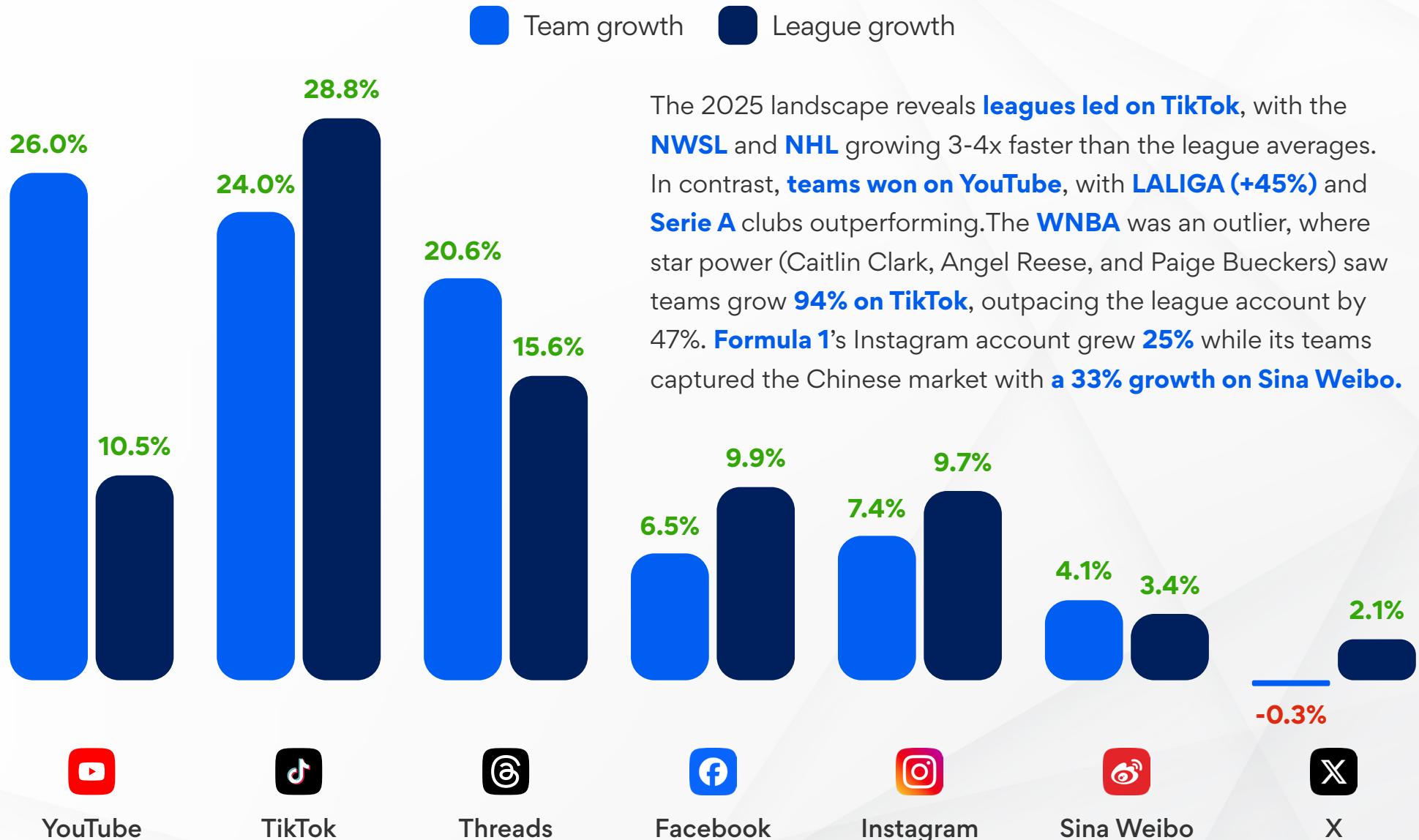

ENGAGEMENT EFFICIENCY



The **Indian Premier League (IPL)** and **WNBA** teams are generating significantly higher engagement relative to their audience size (277.2 million and 15.9 million) compared to other teams in leagues. This tells us that IPL and WNBA teams have a highly active and passionate fanbase.

Engagement-to-Follower Ratio: Teams in League



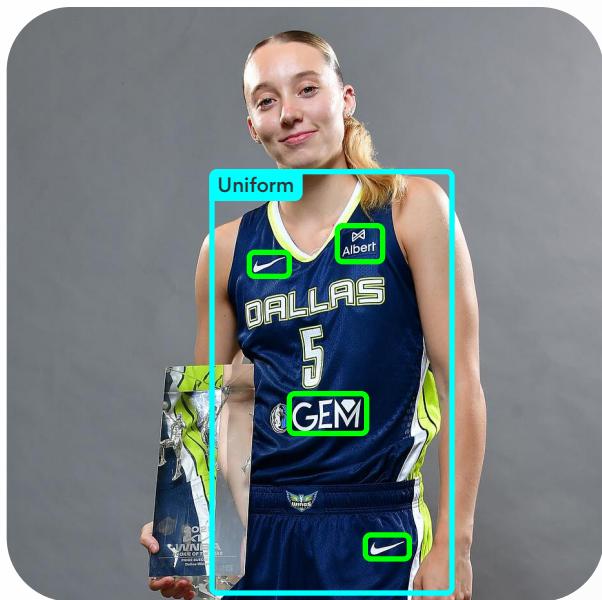

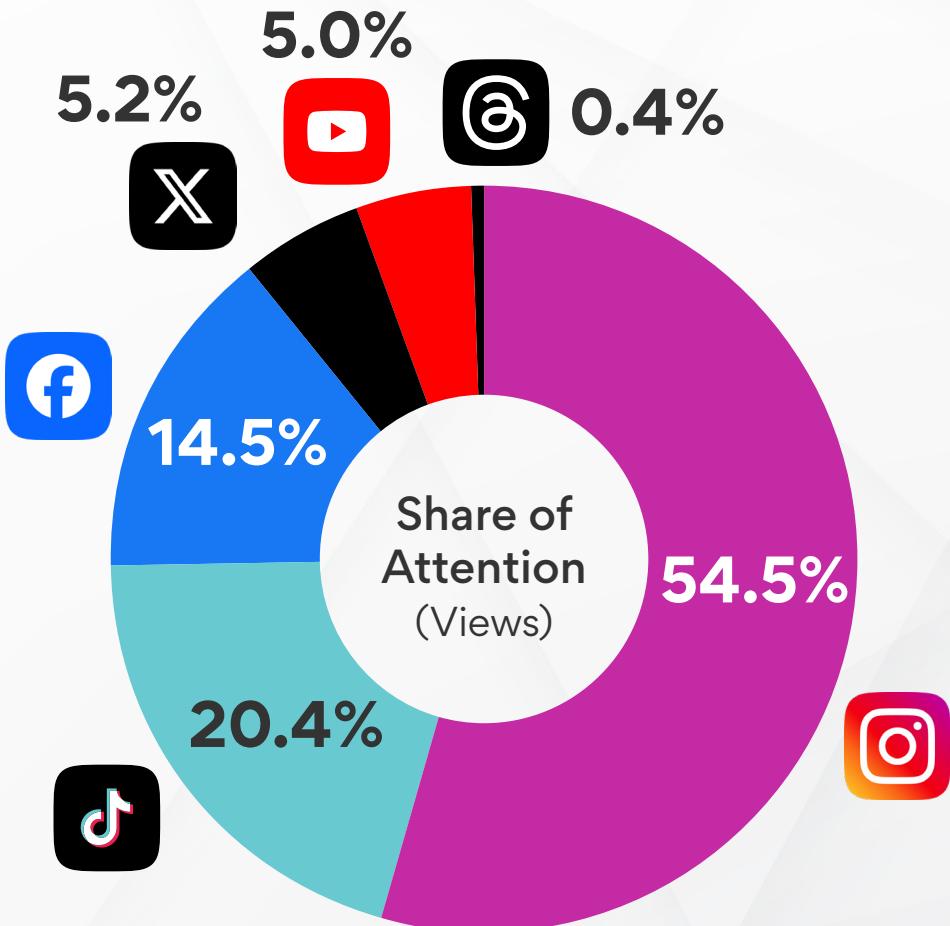
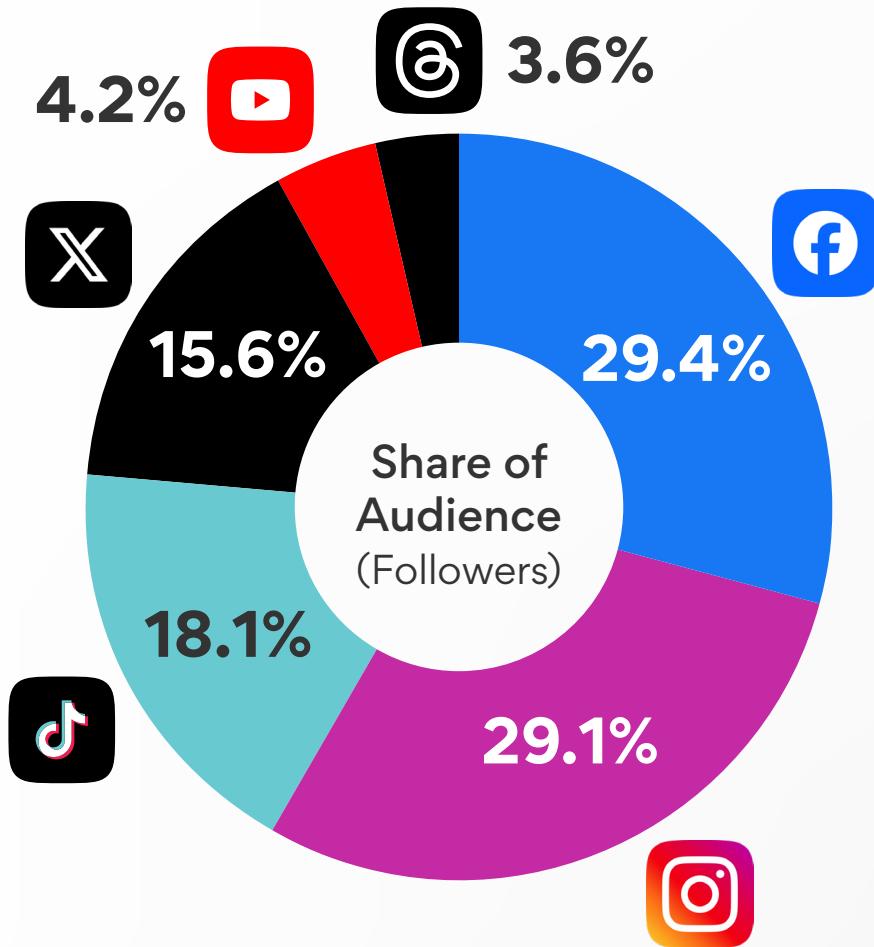
While teams in the **LALIGA** and the **Premier League** dominate with more than 1.2 billion followers each, the **WNBA** and **Kings League** generate significantly more views per follower (191 and 111 respectively). The **Indian Premier League** teams are the only entity to combine massive scale (277.2 million followers) with this high-level viral engagement.

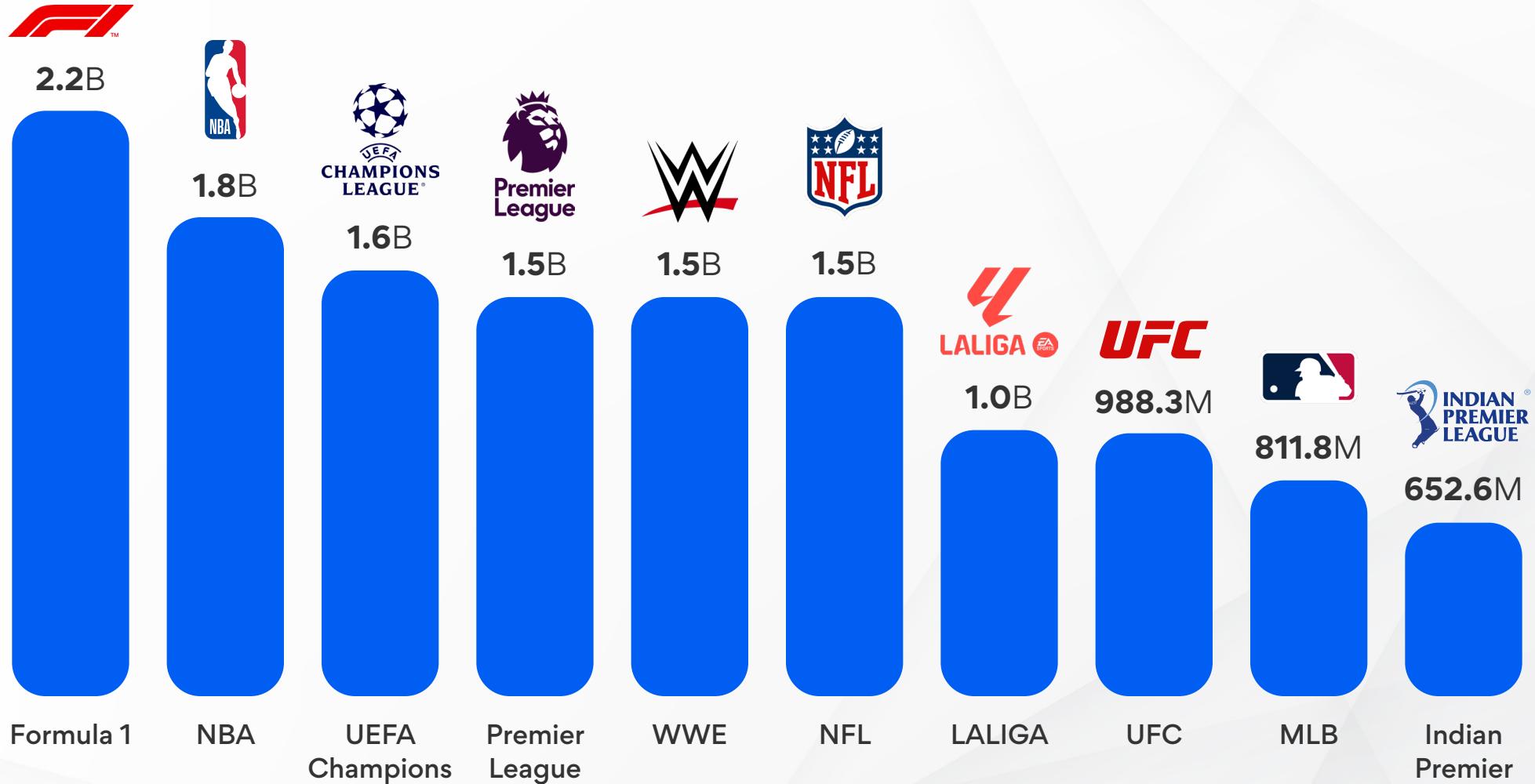

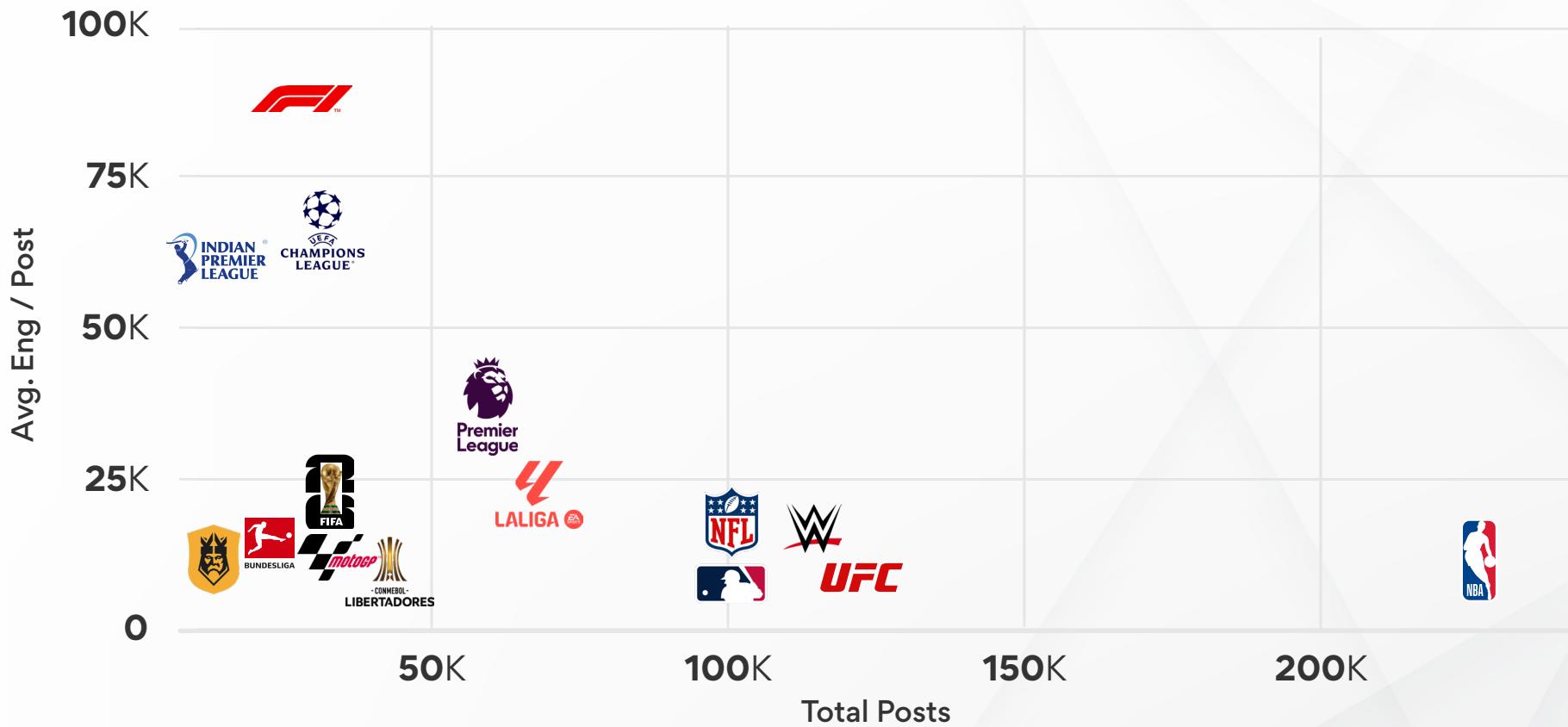
TOTAL ENGAGEMENT | BY LEAGUE

QUALITY VS QUANTITY

Avg. Engagement per Post vs Total Posts: Leagues



Formula 1 is the clear outlier in efficiency. With only 25,000 posts (about 10% of the NBA's volume), F1 generates higher total engagement (2.1 billion) than the NBA (1.8 billion), resulting in a large average engagement of **86,000 per post**. The NBA (228,000 posts), UFC (109,000), and NFL (100,000) rely on a high-volume strategy.

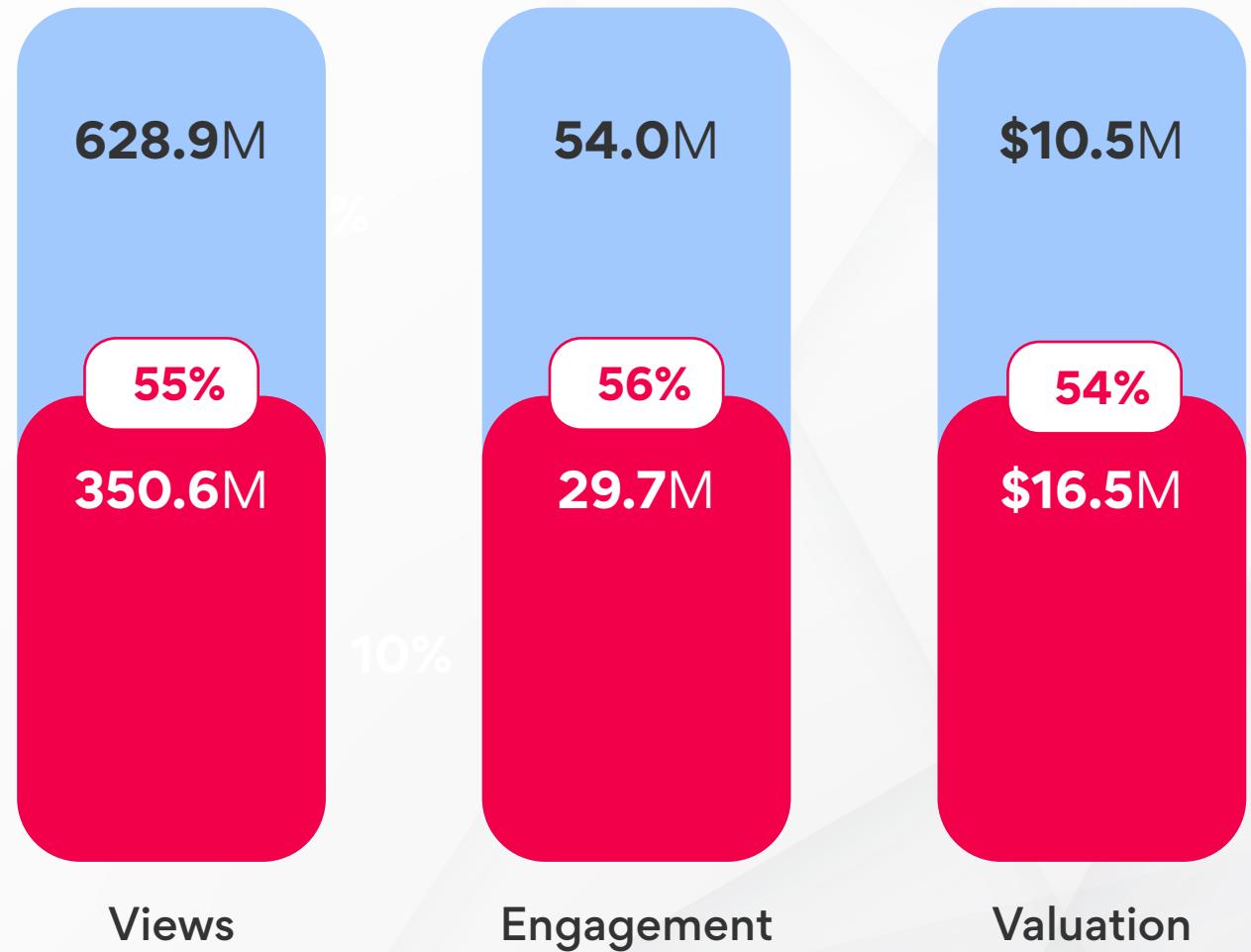
Blinkfire analyzed every moment of this year's thrilling seven-game World Series, capturing the full picture of sponsorship performance and media impact across Fox's TV coverage. The series totaled an impressive **104 million viewers across FOX's coverage**, with Game 7 drawing 27.3 million, the largest World Series audience since 2017. With that level of attention, brands like Capital One, Strauss, and Guggenheim saw major returns in visibility and media value from these broadcasts.

Despite ranking twelfth in followers among the 16 NBA playoffs teams, the Indiana Pacers drove the second-most engagement. Also, the Pacers saw four engagements for every one follower, which was 9.7x higher than the median engagement-to-follower ratio of teams.

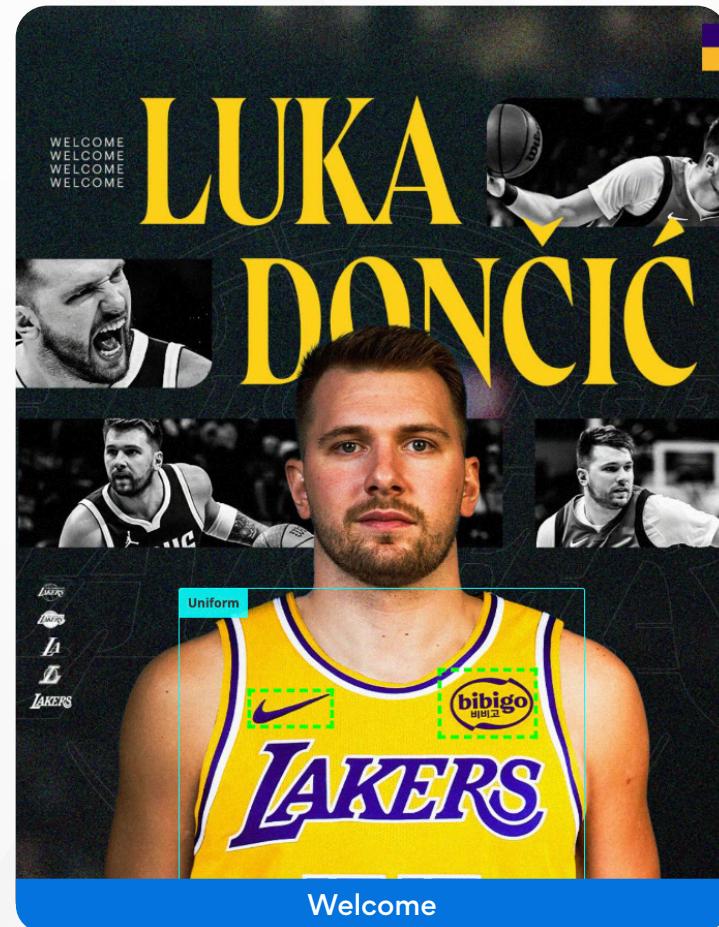

4 NATIONS FACE-OFF

The Four Nations Face-Off proved to be more than just an international hockey showcase. With powerhouse teams from the U.S., Canada, Sweden, and Finland battling it out, fans were treated to high-stakes matchups that outpaced the normal All-Star Game during this break in the NHL season.

USA Hockey in particular saw a huge boost, growing its social media following by 9.5% over the course of the tournament. However, it was Team Canada who lifted the cup in the championship game!

The buzz peaked on championship gameday, when earned social media posts using **#4Nations** drove over 3.4 million **total engagements** and generated a staggering \$1.9 million in total media value.

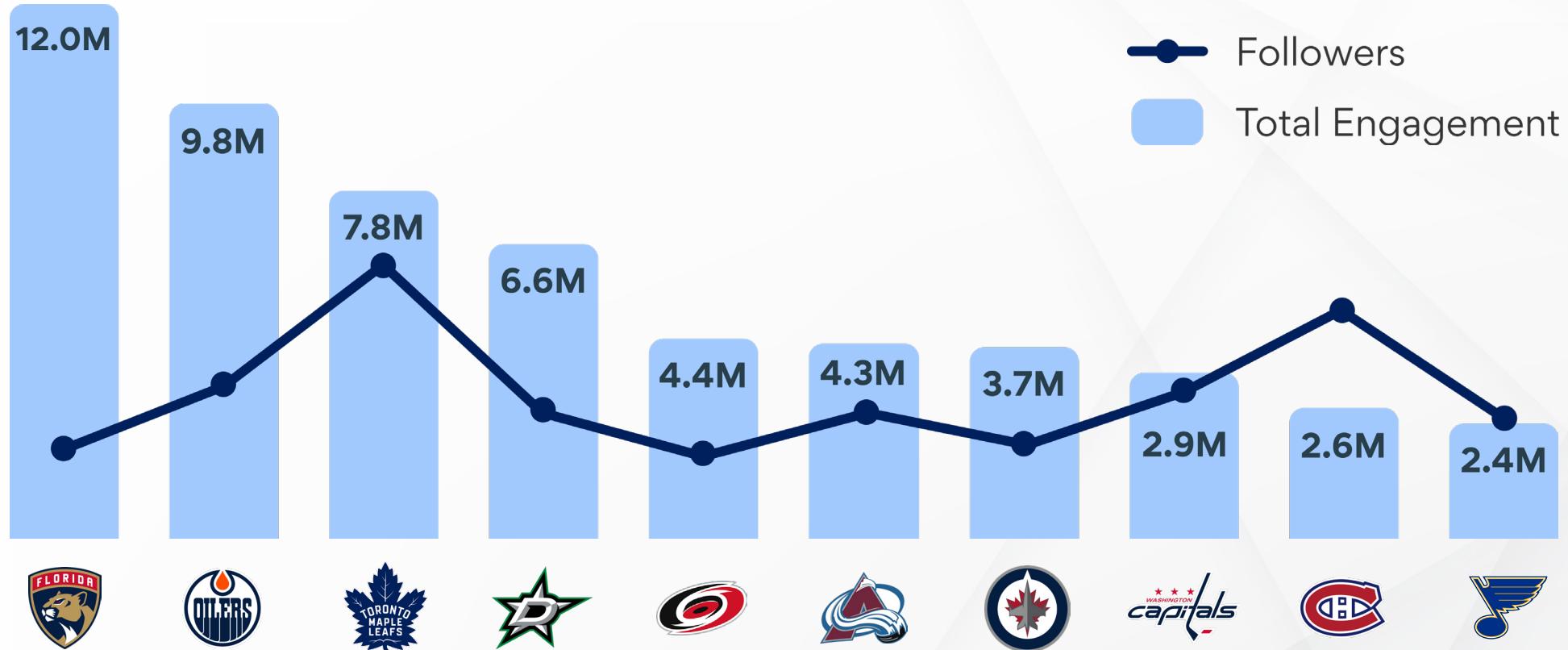

FLORIDA PANTHERS | STANLEY CUP CHAMPIONS

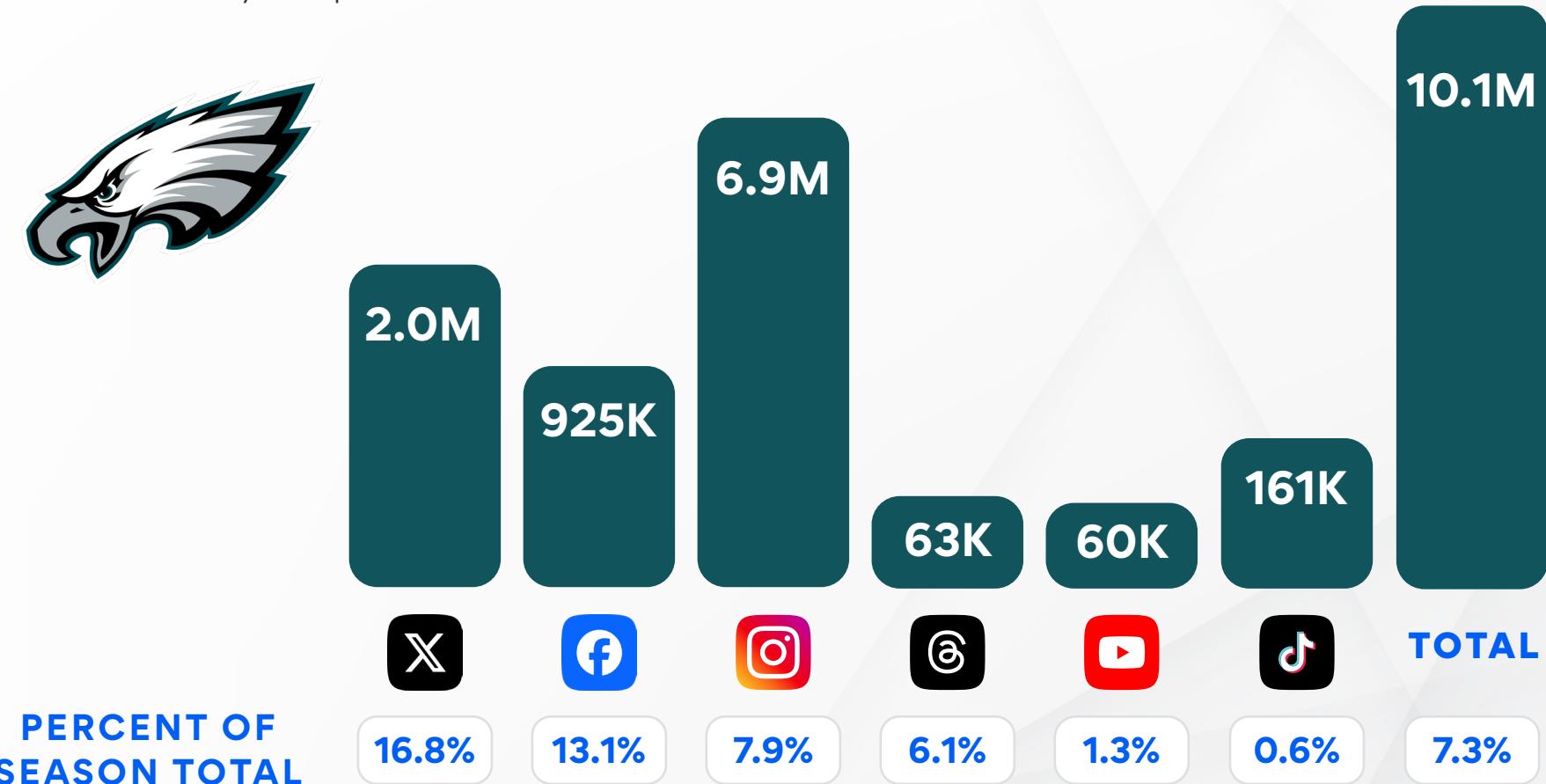


During the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs, teams generated 68.9 million engagements, 554.8 million video views, and \$39.9 million in media value. Despite ranking 14th in followers, Florida led all teams in engagements, views, and media value, with per-follower rates 6-7x the playoff median.

During Super Bowl LIX, the Philadelphia Eagles saw a surge in social media activity, with more than 10.1 million total engagements across platforms. Remarkably, that **single day accounted for 7.3% of their entire season's engagement**, showing the Super Bowl's unmatched ability to capture attention both on and off the field.



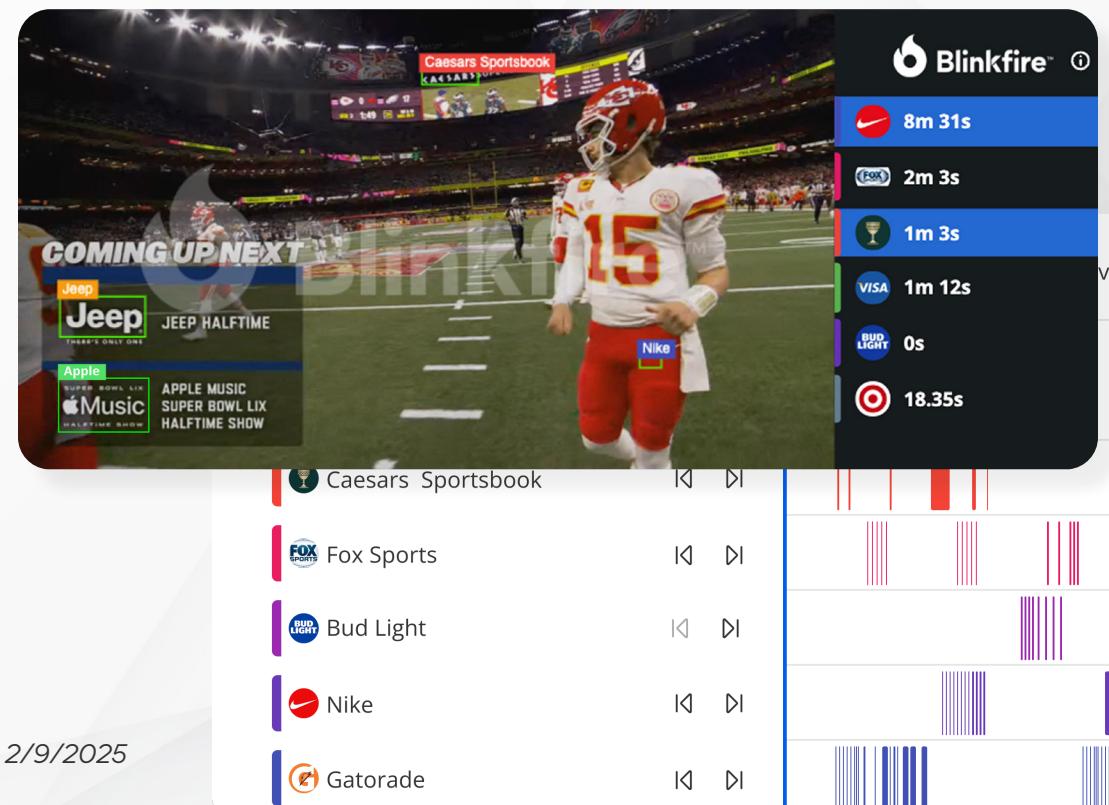

SUPER BOWL LIX: BROADCAST BRAND EXPOSURE

FOX Sports' Super Bowl LIX broadcast saw 127.7 million viewers watch the Kansas City Chiefs vs. Philadelphia Eagles. Brands battled for primetime exposure with Caesars Sportsbook generating more than \$2.3 million in media value. Jeep, prominently featured on the NFL's analyst desk, drove impressive value at \$1.8 million. Meanwhile, Bud Light secured over \$1.3 million in value, proving that well-placed branding during the Super Bowl can make a major impact.

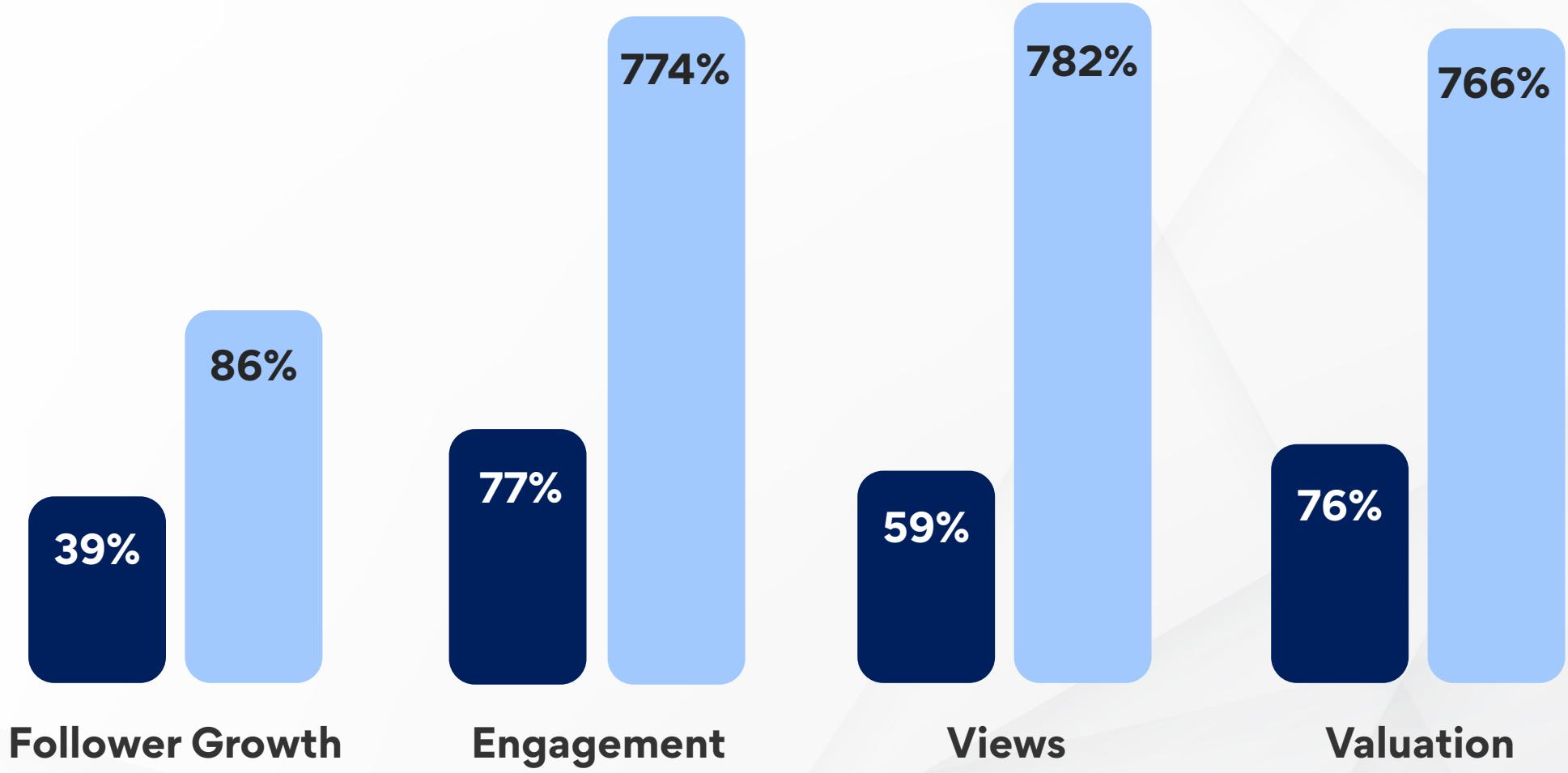

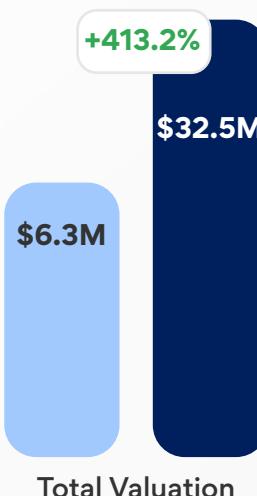
As the NWSL continues to expand across the country, it's important to understand where teams' growth is coming from online. The Kansas City Current lead the pack with an impressive 66.7% surge in followers, far outpacing the rest of the field in 2025. The San Diego Wave FC and Chicago Stars FC follow with strong 26% growth each. It's another sign that fan interest across the league continues to climb. Overall, TikTok, Facebook, and YouTube are the channels seeing the most growth for NWSL teams.

During the 2023-24 and 2024-25 seasons, the Premier League's TikTok achieved outstanding results, showing that its strategy of significantly increasing content was well-received by fans.

Posts on the Premier League's TikTok channel exceeded 2,500, a 365% increase accompanied by a 59.3% rise in followers.

TikTok's success also showed in performance metrics: views soared past 3.2 billion, up more than 400%, while channel valuation climbed fivefold to \$32.5 million.

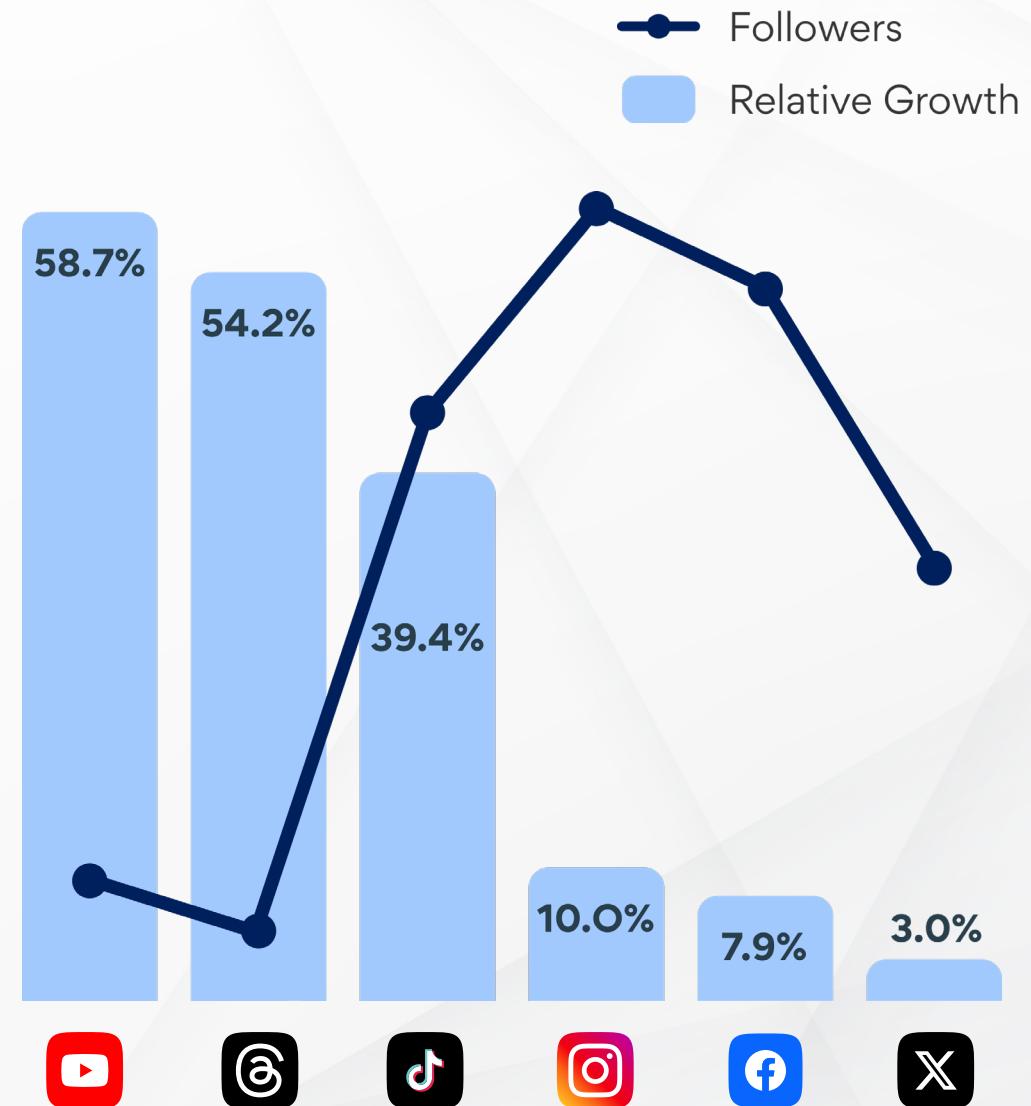

YouTube led LALIGA platforms in relative growth (58.7%), adding more than 54 million followers and reinforcing video's dominance in content strategy. Threads followed closely (54.2%), emerging as a strong conversational platform that could challenge X, which saw the lowest growth despite high posting volume.

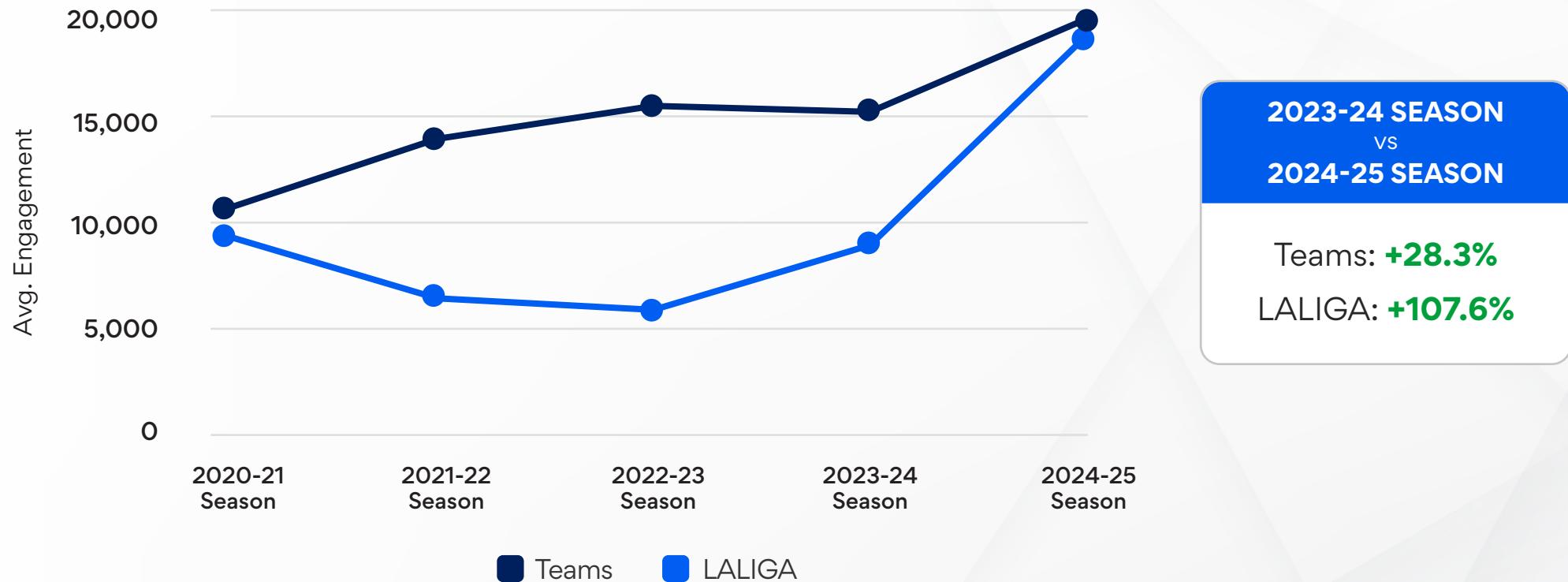

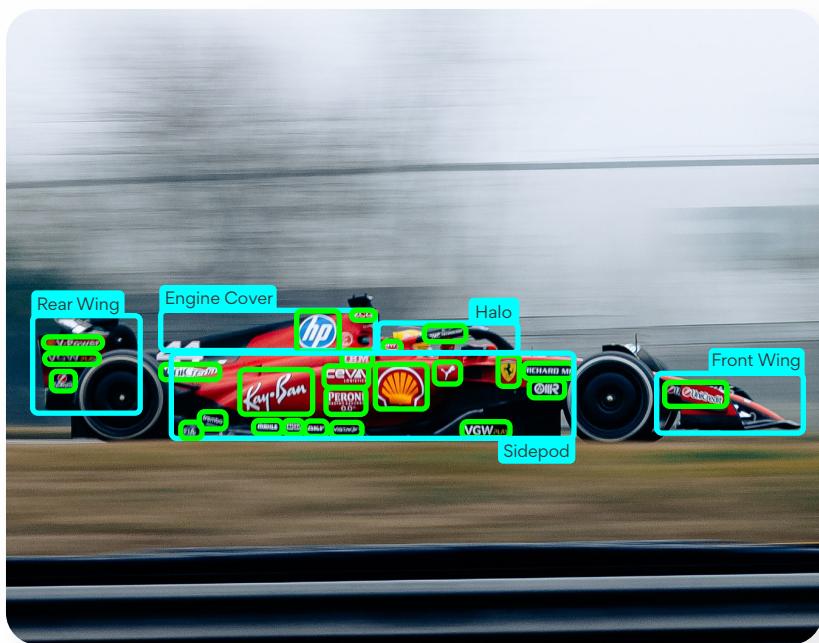
LALIGA & TEAMS | AVERAGE ENGAGEMENT EVOLUTION

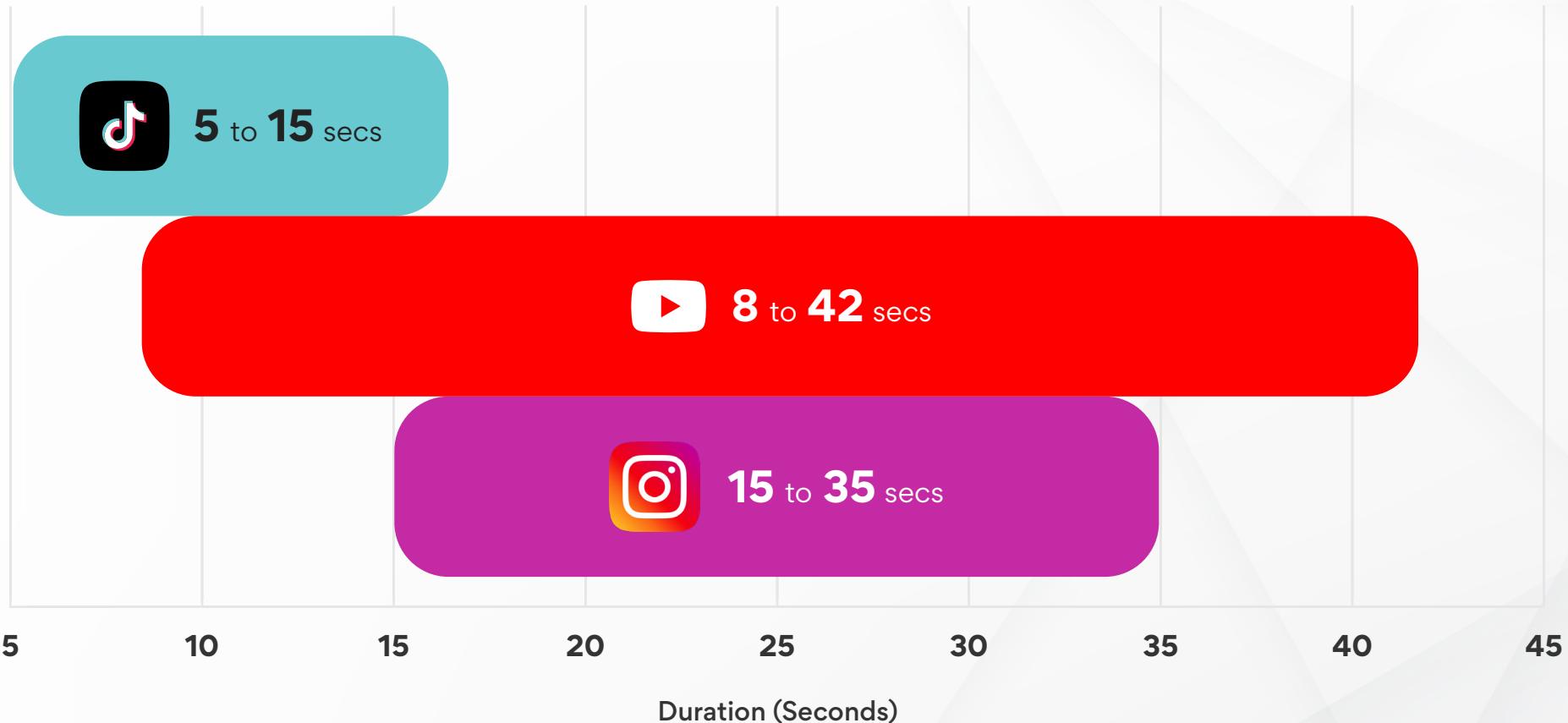

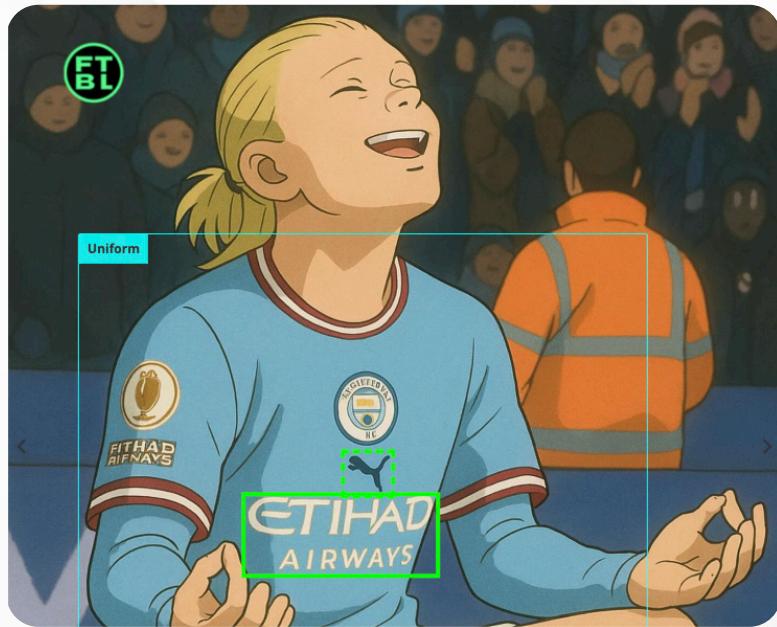
